WAYNAKAY MOVEMENT

Montevideo – Uruguay, 21 March 2015

Family Medicine residents and junior doctors from the Iberoamerican region have participated actively in the 4th Iberoamerican Family and Community Medicine Conference “*Quality and Equality in Healthcare*” with the goal of fortifying the Waynakay Movement.

Waynakay’s objectives include strengthening Family and Community Medicine in Iberoamerican countries, promoting leadership, medical education, research and exchanges between junior doctors within our specialty. The Movement unites the residents and family doctors within 5 years of completion of specialty training - with each country being represented by a primary and backup delegate.

The residents and junior family doctors belonging to the Waynakay Movement will be active members of their respective national Family Medicine society with the purpose of collaborating and participating at the national level as well. We advocate for the modification of the statutes, in WONCA CIMF as well as the societies of which it is comprised, to allow the inclusion of the Waynakay Movement to participate in the executive decision-making process

Three delegates have unanimously been selected to lead the Waynakay Movement - Andrea De Angulo from Colombia, Rodolfo Deusdará from Brasil and Virginia Cardozo from Uruguay - who will represent the Movement to WONCA Iberoamerica - CIMF until the XXI WONCA World Family Medicine Conference. They will work for the rights, duties, and interests of the residents and junior family doctors through activities performed by Waynakay as well as by the CIMF special interest groups.

The residents and junior family doctors, together as the Waynakay Movement declare:

1. To accept and support the inclusion of the Waynakay Movement as a working group within WONCA Iberoamerica – CIMF, assuming the responsibility and commitment to work as a team
2. To advocate for the integration of residents and junior family doctors within member countries of CIMF who have not yet participated in the Waynakay Movement while strengthening the presence of the current members

3. To continue developing various aspects within Waynakay in order to:
- Amplify the lines of communication between its members in order to promote academic as well as cultural integration and exchange.
 - Improve research within primary care as well as Family and Community Medicine.
 - Collaborate with scientific societies so as to guarantee the quality of human talent formation within Family and Community Medicine.
 - Promote well being within residents and junior family doctors within the region.

The Waynakay Movement reaffirms its unconditional support to WONCA Iberoamerica – CIMF and its commitment to work with Young Doctor Movements within WONCA.
